Personal hygiene

Episiotomy

Swelling at the episiotomy site peaks about 72 hours after the procedure. The perineal area should be kept clean and dry to avoid infection.

Douching Alternative

Using hydro-hygienic washing rather than douching products will greatly reduce the possibility of preterm Birth, VYI, PID and Ectopic Pregnancy.

Prevention of UTI

By keeping the urethra clean from bacteria, most commonly– E. Coli left behind through defecation, UTI can be prevented.

Toilet Paper and Prevention Nosocomial Infections

Toilet paper cannot remove all harmful bacteria from the rectal area. The genitalia and rectal area should be washed to prevent the spread of harmful bacteria (nosocomial infections) from the rectum.

80% of all PreTerm Births are associated with Vaginal Infections.

Vaginal Yeast Infections
Pelvic Inflammatory Diseases (PID)***

These can also lead to low birth weight ectopic Pregnancy

Hemorrhoid Treatment

Hemorrhoids are common after birth

Many women develop hemorrhoids during pregnancy and after giving birth. Hemorrhoids are varicose veins of the rectum caused by the weight and pressure of the baby and the force of pushing.

Hemorrhoids are aggravated by rectal pressure during defecation
